## REGULATORY ENVIRONMENT

All Pest Control Products are regulated by PCPB in Kenya under PCP Act Cap. 346 which:

- Defines illegal products
- -Prescribes fines and penalties for offenders
- -Prescribes importation, distribution and sale.

Other legislation of concern;

- IP registration (KIPI), Trade (ACA and KECOBO).
- Recordation of IPR with ACA to commence in 2023

## IMPACT OF ILLEGAL PCP's


- Crop and livestock losses from ineffective control



# AFRICA (KENYA)

UNDER THE SUSTAINABLE PESTICIDE MANAGEMENT FRAMEWORK (SPMF),

### a multi-year, multi-country program

that launched in 2021 in Kenya, CropLife International and CropLife Kenya trained

#### 41 customs officials

in the port of Mombasa to identify illegal pesticides smuggled via vessels.

Training farmers to identify counterfeit pesticides is one of the core elements of CropLife International's anti-counterfeit strategy.
